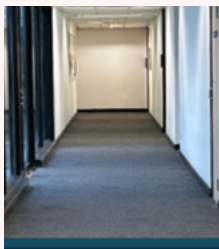

Fire Safety on Campus: Your Actions Matter

Fire safety is a fundamental concern for everyone in our community. It goes beyond compliance with regulations; it's about safeguarding lives and ensuring a secure environment for all. Each of us has a crucial role to play in promoting fire safety and preventing hazards on campus.



How you can help ensure a fire safe environment

- Ensure the corridors and emergency escape routes are kept clear of any obstruction to facilitate safe and efficient movement during emergency situations.



- Ensure that the emergency vehicular access (EVA) is kept clear, and no parking in this area to allow emergency vehicles to reach the site.



- Keep fire doors closed and do not prop them open to prevent smoke from spreading when there is a fire.



- Avoid overloading electrical outlets; use power strips with surge protectors if required.

- Adhere to the university's no-smoking policy.



- Attend fire safety training to know how to use fire extinguisher, activate fire alarm bell and use of fire hose reel.



- Participate in fire drills to know how to respond in an emergency and familiarize yourself with the means of escape.
