
DISPOSAL OF LABORATORY BATTERY (RECHARGEABLE)

4 common waste rechargeable batteries are found on campus and can be collected for recycling:

- Lead-acid
- Lithium ion (Li-ion)
- Nickel metal hydride (NiMH)
- Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd)

Research-made coin batteries:

Lithium metal (or ion)





• Sodium, Potassium metal, or other reactive / hazardous substances Disposal (primary or single-use) batteries: e.g. alkaline, zinc carbon
